In 2007 Fonterra undertook a major redevelopment of their Powder 3 facility at Waitoa in the Waikato, as part of a major investment to increase manufacturing capacity of nutritional milk powders.

The redevelopment included converting the original building and plant, which was designed to manufacture whole milk, to a plant capable of manufacturing high quality specialty products such as infant formulas.

Sika flooring was chosen for the new plant by building and process consultants, Stiles Hooker and Associates Ltd and Fonterra's design consultant, Dickson Lonergan Ltd, along with constructor, Livingstone Building Ltd, after reviewing all the flooring options.

Sika approved contractor, New Zealand Specialised Coatings Ltd said the installation offered many challenges including very tight time constraints and installation over green concrete. Furthermore, during installation, incomplete roofing allowed water to flow over their newly completed work.
